


Connecting to IUPUI Library Resources from Off Campus?

Authenticating as an IUPUI User:

The most important piece of information you need is your IUPUI Username and Passphrase...these are the same ones that you use to log into OnCourse or OneStart. Most library resources are proprietary databases that are only available to IUPUI-affiliated users, and require this information for authentication.

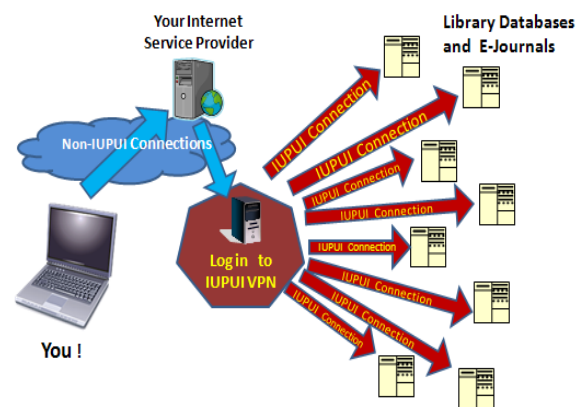

Establishing a VPN (Virtual Private Network) with the campus:

To avoid logging in each time you switch databases or E-Journals, activate an IUPUI VPN connection. You can establish a VPN regardless of how you are accessing the internet (Dial-Up Modem / DSL / Cable Modem). Most users can install the software directly from: <http://iuware.iu.edu> – just search for 'VPN' and select a version that says IUPUI and matches your computer's operating system.
