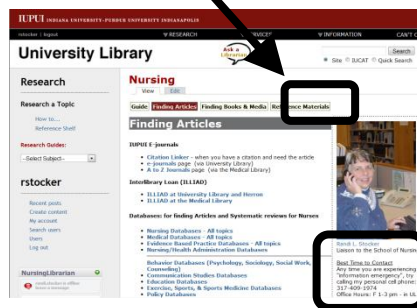
- Get tips from tutorials
