Institutional Repositories, Overview

□ Definition:

- “... a university-based institutional repository is a **set of services** that a university offers to the members of its community for the management and dissemination of digital materials created by the institution and its community members. It is most essentially an **organizational commitment** to the stewardship of these digital materials, including long-term preservation where appropriate, as well as organization and access or distribution.”

Objectives of IU's IR

- Access and Preservation
- Make works Public; an act of publishing
- Increase the use of IU's research output
- Participate in Open Access
- Bring together disparate content
- Collect/Publish 'grey literature'
- Publish new media
- Meet faculty unmet needs
- Keep cost low; reduce barrier to entry

- Depositing
- Clearing Copyrights
- Advising faculty on seeking permissions from publishers to deposit
- Providing Use Statistics; light and heavy weight
- Providing Embargoes if desired or required
- Tracking Versions

An Example

- Faculty Annual Report (FAR)
 - ▣ Faculty member fills out annual report
 - ▣ Faculty member checks box to indicate interest in repository deposit
 - ▣ Library staff checks SHERPA/RoMEO
 - ▣ Library staff contact faculty for correct version
 - ▣ Library staff upload paper, assign metadata

Managerial thoughts

- Plan for organizational change—a constant
- Develop an organizational structure that supports current and future workflows
- Create staffing plan for future based on current and potential staff skills
- Keep informed on general developments in library to see where staff skills might fit well
- Be open to new areas of work not in personal area of expertise

Preparing Staff

- Talk about the future of libraries
- Share trends as they become apparent
- Encourage staff to develop technology skills and be open to new opportunities
- Encourage staff to attend local professional development programs (IR's, digital streaming, etc.)
- Develop cross training situations
- Reassure staff about timelines
- Involve staff when possible; use pilot projects

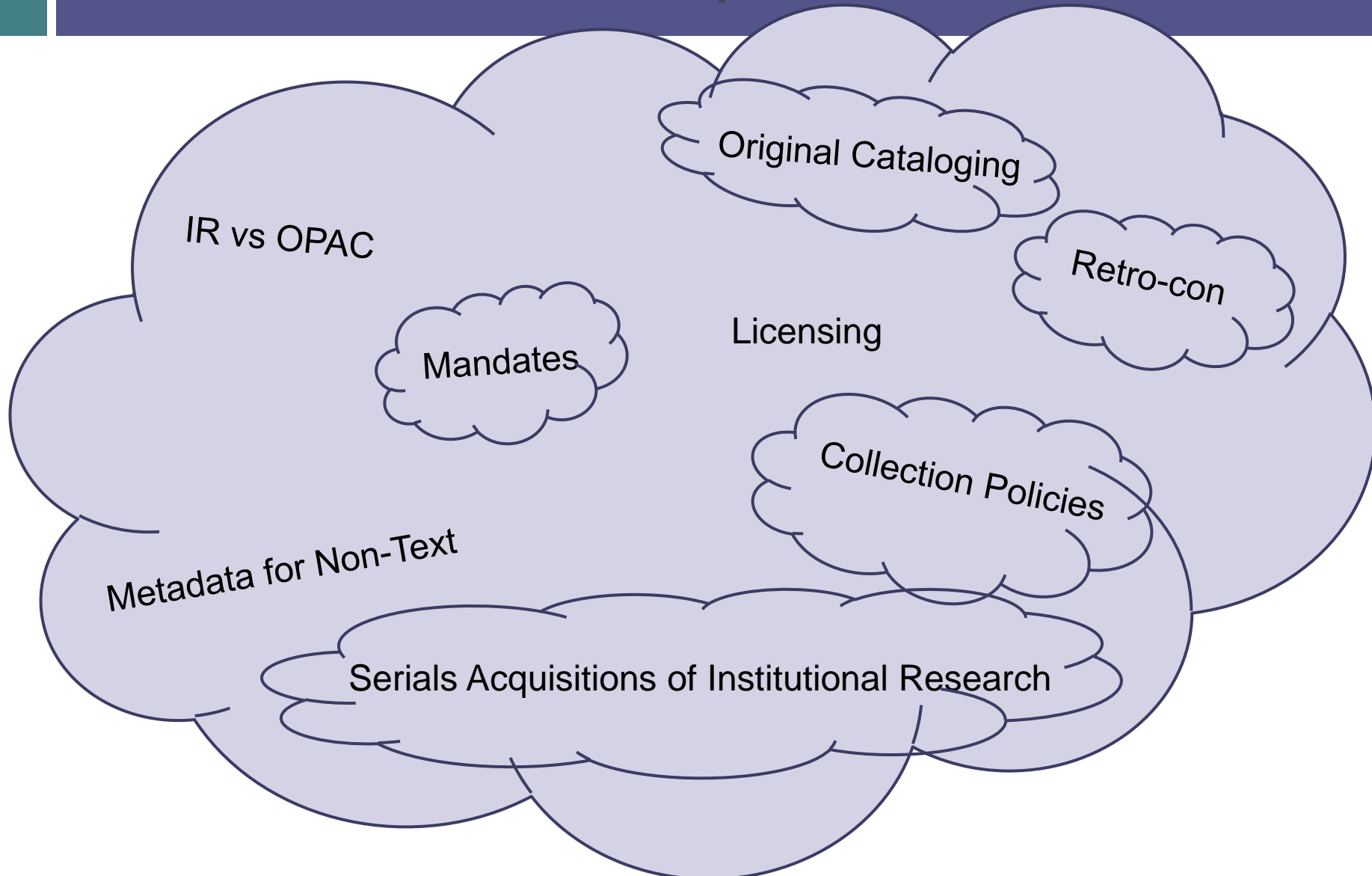
